

1. 0 ENVIRONMENTAL POLICY STATEMENT

General Statement of Policy

The Company acknowledges that its work activities could have an adverse impact upon the environment, and it is committed to limiting all impacts as far as is reasonably practicable.

The company will meet this commitment by:

- Complying fully with all current statutory requirements.
